Iowa Communities Assurance Pool (ICAP) is a group self-insurance program for Iowa public entities that was formed in 1986, during a time when municipalities were struggling to find insurance coverage at pricing they could afford. Under Iowa Code 670.7, ICAP was created to provide those municipalities with a solution - coverage via a group self-insurance program, rather than insurance through the standard marketplace. ICAP is still providing that solution (and so much more!) to Iowa municipalities today. In fact, the ICAP program has grown to count nearly 800 Iowa public entities as members in the Pool - including 74 of Iowa's 99 counties.

Headquartered in Iowa, ICAP has representatives located throughout the state. Kasi Koehler says, "Our local presence and hands-on approach means we are in touch with Iowans - we are Iowans - and we both know and care about what is happening in our member communities."

ICAP just moved to their new Clive office and joined the Chamber as soon as they knew their new office had been selected. They look forward to getting more involved with the Chamber and supporting other businesses in the area.

Municipal representatives should know that everything ICAP does and offers is tailored to meet and exceed the needs of public entities throughout the state.
